

Chesapeake Run Recap:

The MSGA's second 2009 event was held at Chesapeake Run in North Judson, IN on May 27th. The event was the MSGA's first Member/Guest event of the year. The weather was threatening for much of the day, but by the end of the round, the day turned out to be quite nice. The turnout was 86 players including 14 guests. The course played relatively easy as 27 players bested par and eight others matched par with their handicaps.

The highlight of the day was Jim Woodrow's hole-in-one on hole #2 which played at 135 yards. Jim was playing as a guest and the shot was his first of the day as his group started on #2. After his round, Jim said, "That was the only good shot I hit all day". Congratulations to Jim.

In the Individual Medal competition, overall low gross was won by Rob Hocevar with a great 74, which he finished off with a short birdie putt on 18. For the day, Rob had four birdies in his round and a net 60 with his handicap. Dan Weaver was second with a 76. Overall low net was a tie between Bob Brady, Jim Wiggins and Pete Candela with 67's, with Bob winning the tie-breaker. In the Skins competition, multiple winners were Rob Hocevar with three skins, and Jim Mellon, Pat Weiss, Jerry Orman and Jim Kintzele with two each. Overall, in the four flights, there were 32 skins.
