## Blackthorn G. C. Recap:

The MSGA's fourth tournament of 2010, a combined Regular Individual Medal play event and Two-man Team Low-Net event (one best ball), was held at Blackthorn G. C. in South Bend on June 28th. The turnout was excellent with 104 players participating.

The weather was perfect with temperatures in the low 80's, gentle breezes and plenty of sunshine. The golf course was in great condition with the greens very receptive to good shots and quite fast and true, leading to many excellent scores. Overall with handicaps, 41 players bested par of 72 and eight others matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, the overall low gross winner was Dan Weaver with a three over par 75. Dan's round included an eagle on #15 and three birdies. Roger Stevens, Jerry Pado and Louie Slabach tied for second, four shots back with 79's. Lou Torres won low net with an eight under 64. Lou's round included one net eagle and nine net birdies. Bruce Fisher, Steve Raymond, Scott Dolfman and Jim Hutton tied for second with net 66's.

In the Team Best-Ball Low-Net competition, Scott Dolfman and Bruce Fisher won first place with a net best-ball score of 57. Two teams tied for second with scores of 58.
