

Innsbrook C. C. Recap:

The MSGA's sixth tournament of 2010, a Regular Individual Medal play event, was held at Innsbrook C. C. in Merrillville, Indiana on July 26th. The turnout was 82 players. It was the MSGA's third tournament at Innsbrook C. C. over the years.

The weather was near perfect with plenty of sunshine and temperatures in the mid 80's and little wind. The golf course was in great condition considering all the rain it received over the previous few days. The soft greens were very receptive to good shots and many great scores. Several sloping greens made for some very interesting downhill putts although with the rains, the greens were slow. Overall with handicaps, 37 players bested par of 72 with eight others matching par.

In the Individual Medal competition, the overall low gross winner was Steve Kahn with a two over par 74. Steve's round included two birdies and four bogies. Mike Gilpin was second with a 77 with seven others shooting 80 or better. Pete Candela was the low net winner with a nine under par 63. Steve Kahn, Jim Bell and Jim Donnelly were one shot back with net 64's. Bob McFadden and Dave Mason were next with net 65's.

In the Skins competition, Brian Chalik was the only multiple winner with two skins. In total, there were 18 skins in the four flights. Congratulations to prize winners in all the flights, a list of which can be found on the Tournament Results tab.

In the season-long Brady Cup competition, Mike Gilpin continues to lead with 1115 points with Jim Fyock holding second with 980 points.
