

Warren Course at Notre Dame Recap:

The MSGA's second tournament of 2010, a Member/Guest event, was held at Warren Course at Notre Dame on June 1st. The turnout was 132 players, the largest in more than five years. Twelve guests played in the tournament.

The weather was very warm with temperatures in the mid 80's and lots of sunshine. The golf course was in great condition, but with plenty of heather and some very thick rough. The sloping and undulating greens were tough to read and judge speed. Overall with handicaps, fifteen players bested par of 71 and six matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, overall low gross went to Mike Basney with an even par 71, an excellent score considering he beat the field by five shots. Eldon Miller was second with a 76. Mike Gilpin and Mike Lake tied for low net with six under 65's with Mike Gilpin winning the tie-breaker. Mike Conway and Eldon Miller were a shot back with 66's.

In the Skins competition, multiple winners were Norm Drenten with three skins and Chuck Bridegroom and Jack Niland with two each. In total, there were 21 skins in the four flights. Congratulations to prize winners in all the flights, a list of which can be found on the Tournament Results tab.
