

## **Stonehenge Golf & C. C. Recap: July 9, 2012**

The MSGA's fifth tournament of 2012 was held at the Stonehenge Golf and C. C. in Winona Lake, IN on July 9th. The tournament was the MSGA's first visit to Stonehenge and proved to be a great course for the members.

The turnout was a solid 95, extending the good turnouts for all five 2012 events.

The weather was quite hot with temperatures around 90 degrees, but with a slight breeze. The golf course was in good condition considering the extreme drought in the area. Scores were very low with the lack of rough and thinned fescue grasses that had also been cut. Overall with handicaps, 41 players bested par of 71 and 10 others matched par. The average net score for all players was a very low 72.1 strokes.

In the Individual Medal competition, Louie Slabach won Low Gross with a three over par 74. Don Herakovich, John Brindley and Tom Workman followed with 76's while seven others were two more shots back with 78's.

In the Low Net competition, Bruce Fisher was the overall winner with an excellent ten under par net 61. Steve Reinhart was next with net 62, followed by Tom Workman and Steve Raymond with net 63's. Jerry Pado, Gil Vayhinger, Dick Sierra and Leon Kaminski were two more shots back with net 66's.

In the Skins competition, John Psarakas and Rich Schmitt were multiple winners with two skins each. In total, there were 28 skins in the four flights.

In the Closest-to-the-Pin contest, Steve Reinhart's shot on the 124 yard Hole # 5 was closest at one foot, one inch.

Congratulations to award winners in all the flights and especially to Louie Slabach and Bruce Fisher for winning the overall Low Gross and overall Low Net awards. A complete list of winners can be found on the Tournament Results tab.
